All families should fill out a parish census form (in the rack at the entrance of church) to be formally registered at St. Lawrence Church.

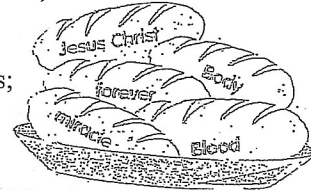
CHRISTIAN BURIAL
